EDITORIAL EXCELLENCE – 1-5 points for each item, maximum 15 points

- 1. The writing is clear, understandable and grammatically correct.
- 2. The content is appropriate and attention getting for intended audience.
- 3. The information is timely and informative.

APPROPRIATE DESIGN and TYPOGRAPHY – 1-5 points for each item, maximum 15 points

- 1. The design is attractive and appropriate for the intended audience.
- 2. The design supports the text.
- 3. Is the use of color effective?

PHOTOS/ILLUSTRATIONS - 1-5 points for each item, maximum 10 points

- 1. Photos are effectively used to tell a story.
- 2. The design supports the message being conveyed.

OVERALL IMPRESSIONS AND RESULTS – 1-5 points for each item, maximum 15 points

- 1. Did the Award entry clearly state the purpose and/or goals for the production or project?
- 2. Did the Award entry successfully achieve that purpose and/or meet the stated goals?
- 3. Overall impression of the publication.
