

I created a group called **Paddle Together** and now over 70 of my neighbors and I coordinate community paddles.







When you receive your homeowners insurance declarations page from your insurance company, which of the following describes what you do? When you purchase a homeowners insurance policy, when you renew your policy, or when you make any changes to your policy, the company will give you a document called a "declarations page." The declarations page identifies the kinds and amounts of coverage you have and how much it will cost you. It is very important that you review the declarations page as soon as you get it to be sure it is accurate and that you know what your policy will cover.





One is a requirement for employers to provide appropriate face coverings or masks to all employees who don't work alone. One is a Department of Health statewide order directing all individuals to wear a face covering in any indoor public setting or when outdoors and unable to maintain 6 feet of physical distance from others. There is also a governor's order directing businesses to require and enforce the use of face coverings by all customers or visitors. 


