
CREDENTIALING VS. CERTIFICATION

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?


Any person actively employed full or part-time with, contracted with, or as a volunteer for a federal, state, local or tribal government agency, public safety agency, emergency services organization, or a privately owned industry that is supported by government or that serves in emergency support functions (ESF) that meets either Category A or Category B criteria.

HOW TO APPLY

Download the application for free at the CPSE store on <u>www.cpse.org</u>. Complete all components of portfolio, submit via SharePoint Link, peer review process, goes to Commission for vote (monthly), approved or denied. Cost is \$395 upon submittal.
